

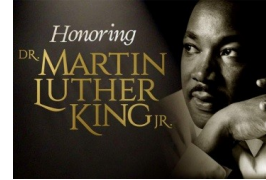

- The parade begins at 10 a.m. and will end at approximately 11 a.m., in the parking lot at West Oaks Mall.
- A "one stop" courtesy shuttle bus will be available to transport parade participants back to Citrus Elementary School. The bus will not provide transportation to other locations. The bus will be located at the former Ruby Tuesday's mall entrance.
- The MLK post-parade festivities will begin at 11 a.m. INSIDE the West Oaks Mall Food Court with keynote speaker, W9TV News Anchor Daralene Jones, Master of Ceremony Allie Braswell, and the winner of Ocoee's Black History Month Essay Contest, 6<sup>th</sup> Grader Hailey Smith, will recite her winning essay.
